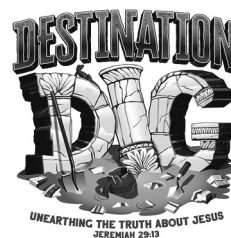
### Pray for: Debbie Vik in Thailand

- In Philemon, He is your benefactor
