# Been Thinking About the Cross Martin DeHaan

Without the cross, the Bible is no comfort. What could be more threatening than to read hundreds of pages of legal requirements, every line of which exposes our personal failures? What could be more discouraging than to read page after page of instructions, all of which are beyond our ability to follow?

Without the cross, the Bible is a dangerous book. Every page is like a many-sided razor blade. After leafing through the writings of Moses or the teachings of Jesus, our hands should be covered with blood. Every principle cuts deep into the flesh, which has so consistently fallen shot of God's unreachable standards.

Without the cross, the Bible destroys me. I read it for strength, but every statement shows my weakness. In principle, I've broken every law in the Book. The worse of my efforts are like federal offenses, each of which demands the death penalty. The best of my own efforts turn out to be no better. Everything is polluted by my own selfishness. Nothing is clean. I have not loved as Christ loved. I haven't obeyed as He obeyed. I've never served as He served. I've never worshiped or prayed or listened or talked as He did. All of my own best efforts really are like filthy rags. (Isaiah 64:6).

But praise God for the cross! Every sin is paid for! The cross has turned the Bible from a hopeless indictment into an endless source of wisdom, counsel, and strength. The cross has turned the Bible from a warrant for our arrest into a statement of our freedom in Christ. Because of the cross, James could call the Word of God the perfect law of liberty! Praise God for the cross! Without the cross, we'd all be dead.
